

TNFRS Conducts Fire and Evacuation Mock Drill at SPR City, February 28, 2026

The Tamil Nadu Fire and Rescue Services (TNFRS) conducted a large-scale Fire and Evacuation Mock Drill at SPR City in Perambur on Saturday, February 28, 2026, to enhance emergency preparedness in high-rise residential and commercial complexes.

The DGP / Director Mrs. Seema Agrawal IPS participated in and oversaw the exercise. She reviewed operational procedures, assessed response time and interacted with officers and residents during the drill. Addressing personnel after the exercise, she emphasised the need for continuous hands-on training, swift coordination and strict adherence to safety protocols while handling emergencies in vertical urban environments.

The mock drill simulated a fire emergency in one of the multi-storey towers within the integrated township. Aerial Ladder platform, Fire tender and various rope rescue methods were deployed to demonstrate coordinated firefighting, search operations and evacuation procedures.

Newly recruited Station Officer trainees from Temporary Training Centre, Gojan Engineering College were actively participated and observed the drill.

Firefighters also demonstrated rescue by parkour technique, high-angle rescue operations, including ladder and rope-based evacuation from elevated floors, showcasing the department's readiness to respond to emergencies in high-rise structures. Residents and facility management staff were briefed on fire safety measures, alarm systems and designated evacuation routes.

The drill concluded successfully, reaffirming TNFRS's commitment to strengthening disaster response capabilities and public safety awareness across Chennai's expanding high-rise developments. Joint Director, Northern Region, Thiru. G.Sathiyarayan, Chennai City District Officers and other officials were present during the mockdrill.
